INDOOR RANGE RULES

SAFETY:

EYE AND EAR PROTECTION IS MANDATORY WHEN THE FIRING LINE IS HOT.

A Cease Fire may be called by anyone for any safety concern. Resume Fire may be called once the safety concern has been resolved.

When calling for a “cold range”:

A. First, check with all persons on the firing line to make sure they are ready for a “cold range” then

B. Stop and look both directions along the firing line to make sure everyone is back behind the firing line and not handling firearms. Chamber flags must be inserted in the chamber.

C. When people are downrange, do not handle any firearms, this includes taking rifles and pistols off the tables or racks. Uncased firearms must have their actions open and chamber flags must be inserted in the chamber. All ammunition and magazines must be removed from the firearms before people may move forward of the firing line.

Make sure everyone is behind the firing line and they understand the firing line is going “hot”.

The target lights/exhaust fan must be on prior to the first shot in any shooting session and must remain on for a minimum of one (1) minute after the last shot is fired.

Pets are not allowed in the classroom or indoor range. Children need to have appropriate protective equipment and be under the direct supervision of an adult at all times.

Any consumption of alcohol is prohibited on club property. No persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs are allowed on club property and must leave with a designated driver.

Smoking is only permitted outside the building.

These operating hours are Monday through Sunday for members only and their invited guests. Matches, training events or construction may limit/prohibit access to the range. Members may bring up to six(6) guests, and are responsible for those guests. All members and guests must sign in and must comply with written policies, signs, and the Range Guide.

There may be occasional closures to facilitate construction and maintenance. These closures can be on very short notice. Signs at the range will indicate if the the facility is available for shooting on any given day.

WHEN YOU USE CR&PC RANGE FACILITIES, YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK. ALL VISITORS MUST SIGN THE LIABILITY RELEASE PRIOR TO USING THE RANGE—THIS INCLUDES BOTH DIRECT PARTICIPATION IN SHOOTING EVENTS AND ATTENDANCE AS A GUEST/OBSERVER. THIS IS A CONDITION OF USE/ADMITTANCE TO CLUB PROPERTY.

Members are required to have an Indoor Range Orientation prior to gaining access to the indoor range. All members and guests must sign in. The daily release forms and sign in sheets are located in a 3-ring binder in the indoor range.
